Ranthambore Tour (16 Nights / 17 Days)



Routing : Delhi - Agra - Ranthambore - Kota - Pushkar - Udaipur - Jodhpur - Jaisalmer - Bikaner - Jaipur - Delhi

Day 01 : Arrival Delhi

Welcome to India! arrive Delhi, meet assist at the airport by our tour executive & then transfer to hotel. Overnight stay in Delhi hotel.

Day 02 : Delhi

Breakfast in Hotel, after a leisurely breakfast proceed for sightseeing tour of Old & New Delhi where ornate buildings recall the days when India was the Jewel in the crown of the British empire. Visit the Red Fort, Raj Ghat, 11th century Qutab Minar, India Gate and the grand government buildings, the President's House, also visit Laxmi Narayan temple popularly known as Birla Temple. Later in the day, drive to Agra - the city of eternal love. On arrival in Agra, check in at the hotel and relax on a day that is free for you to spend shopping, eating out or snoozing in the hotel. Overnight stay in Agra hotel.

Day 03 : Agra

Breakfast in Hotel, after breakfast proceed for city tour of Agra. Taj Mahal - A white marble Tomb building 1631 - 1648 in Agra, seat of the Mughal Empire by Shah Jahan for his wife, Arjuman Banu Begum, the monument sums up many of the formal themes that have played through Islamic architecture. Its refined elegance is a conspicuous contrast both to the Hindu architecture of pre - Islamic India, with its thick walls, corbelled arches and heavy lintels and to the Indo Islamic styles, in which Hindu elements are combined with an electric assortment of motifs from Persian and Turkish sources. The Agra fort - situated on the banks of Yamuna river, north west of the Taj Mahal, this majestic fort was started by the Emperor Akbar and it developed as a strong hold of the Mughal Empire, under successive generations. This majestic fortress of red sandstone encompasses within its 2.5 km long endosure walls, the imperial city of the Mughal rulers. Overnight stay in Agra hotel.

Day 04 : Agra - Ranthambore



Drive to Ranthambore in the morning, enroute visiting Fatehpur Sikri- The Imperial city of the Mughal dynasty. It is very difficult to express the architectural grandeur city as one can only experience the aura of these forts. Famously known as the city of Ghosts, it was built by the great Mughal Emperor. On arrival in Ranthambore National Park and Tiger Reserve, check in at the jungle lodge and unwind amidst natural surroundings. Overnight stay in Ranthambore hotel.

Day 05 : Ranthambore

Early morning 3 hrs Jungle safari in a Canter (a vehicle which is open on the top) enjoy the game viewing in the national park and back to the hotel. After lunch second visit to jungle and enjoy the game viewing again. Overnight stay in Ranthambore hotel.

Day 06 : Ranthambore - Kota

Drive to Kota in the morning. On arrival in the 12th century desert town on the Chambal River, check in at the hotel and immediately proceed for a sightseeing tour that includes visit to City Palace and Fort, Rao Madho Singh Museum, Jagmandir, and Chambal Gardens. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight stay in Kota hotel.

Day 07 : Kota - Pushkar

Drive to Pushkar in the morning. En route, visit Dargah-e-sharif in Ajmer. On arrival in the holy city that hosts the annual cattle fair, check in at the hotel and proceed for a sightseeing tour of the Lord Brahma Temple and the Pushkar Lake. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay in Pushkar hotel.

Day 08 : Pushkar - Udaipur

Drive to Udaipur in the morning. On arrival in the city of lakes and palaces, check in at the hotel and relax on your overnight stay in Udaipur hotel.

Day 09 : Udaipur

In the morning, proceed for a sightseeing tour of the city that includes visits to the Lake Palace, City Palace, Lake Pichola, Saheliyon ki Bari, and Jagdish Temple. Afternoon excursion to Kumbhalgarh Fort is an added attraction. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay in Udaipur hotel.

Day 10 : Udaipur - Jodhpur

Drive to the desert city of Jodhpur in the morning via Ranakpur that is famous for its white marble Jain temples. On arrival in the desert city, check in at the hotel and relax on a day that is free for you spend in shopping or snoozing. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay in Jodhpur hotel.

Day 11 : Jodhpur - Jaisalmer

In the morning, proceed for a half day sightseeing tour that includes visits to Mehrangarh Fort, Moti Mahal, Sheesh Mahal, Phool Mahal, Sileh Khana and Daulat Khana, Jaswant Thada, Umaid Bhavan Palace, and cenotaphs. Later, drive to Jaisalmer. On arrival in the desert citadel, check in at the hotel and relax over dinner and overnight stay in Jaisalmer hotel.

Day 12 : Jaisalmer



In the morning, proceed for a half day sightseeing tour that includes visit the colossal Jaisalmer Fort, royal cenotaphs, Manak Chowk, Patwon Ki Haveli, Salim Singh Ki Haveli, boat rides on Gadisar Lake, and camel safaris to Sam sand dunes. Return to the hotel for and overnight stay in Jaisalmer.

Day 13 : Jaisalmer - Bikaner

Drive to Bikaner in the morning. Detour at Fatehpur that falls on the ancient spice route to Central Asia. On arrival in the desert commercial center of Rajasthan, check in at hotel and relax. In the afternoon, proceed for a half day sightseeing tour that includes visits to the 15th century Junagarh Fort, the many palaces, pavilions, courts and temples with the complex, Lalgarh Palace, and Camel Breeding Farm. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay in Bikaner

Day 14 : Bikaner - Jaipur

Drive to Jaipur in the morning. On arrival, check in at the hotel and relax on a day that is free for you to spend on shopping, eating out, attending cultural programs, and indulging in care free strolls. Overnight stay at the hotel in Jaipur.

Day 15 : Jaipur

In the morning, proceed for a sightseeing tour of the city that includes visits to Amber Fort, City Palace and Museum, Jantar Mantar Observatory, Hawa Mahal, and Birla Temple, Jaigarh Fort, and Nahargarh Fort. Return to the hotel for overnight stay in Jaipur.

Day 16 : Jaipur - Delhi

Drive back to Delhi in the morning (6-hour journey). On arrival, check in at the hotel and relax. You can also go for further sightseeing, shopping and eating out experiences. Overnight stay at the hotel in Delhi.

Day 17 : Departure from Delhi

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the airport to board the flight back home or to your onward destination.
