# Classic Desert Tour (12 Nights / 13 Days)



Routing: Delhi (2N) - Jodhpur (1N) - Jaisalmer (2N) - Bikaner (2N) - Shekhwati region (1N) - Jaipur (2N) - Agra (2N)

#### Day 01: Arrival Delhi

Welcome to capital of India! Arrive Delhi, meet assist at the airport by our tour executive & then transfer to hotel. Night stay in Delhi.

# Day 02: Delhi

After leisurely breakfast in hotel, proceed for sightseeing tour of Old & New Delhi where ornate buildings recall the days when India was the Jewel in the crown of the British empire. Visit the Red Fort, Raj Ghat, 11th century Qutab Minar, India Gate and the grand government buildings, the President's House, also visit Laxmi Narayan temple popularly known as Birla Temple. Night stay in Delhi.

# Day 03: Delhi - Jodhpur (608 km, 9 hours 28 mins)

After relaxed breakfast in hotel, drive to Jodhpur. On arrival transfer to hotel. After noon visit to Maharngarh Fort, Jaswant Thada and Traditional Market. Night stay in Jodhpur hotel.

## Day 04: Day 04: Jodhpur - Jaisalmer (306 km, 4 hours 27 mins)

After breakfast in hotel drive to Jaisalmer, on arrival transfer to hotel. Evening free at leisure. Night stay in Jaisalmer.

## Day 05: Jaisalmer

Breakfast in hotel, then proceed for full Day sight seeing of Jaisalmer Visiting Jaiselmer Fort Museum & the famous Jain Temple. Take a walk through the back streets to the Patwon ki Haveli & Kothari Haveli. Night stay in Jaisalmer.

Day 06: Jaisalmer - Bikaner (381 km, 5 hours 36 mins)

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Breakfast in Hotel, after relaxed breakfast drive to Bikaner on the way visit Deshnok Temple, on arrival transfer to hotel. Night stay in Bikaner.

#### Day 07: Bikaner

After leisurely breakfast in hotel, proceed for sightseeing tour. Bikaner city founded by Raja Rai Singh has a 16th century fort, housing old palaces, temples and mosque also visit Devi Kund Junagarh Fort, Temples in Bikaner, Bhandasar Jain Temple, Shiv Bari Temple, Deshnok Temple, Museums in Bikaner, Camel Breeding Farm. Night stay in Bikaner.

#### Day 08: Bikaner - Mandawa (189 km, 2 hours 45 mins)

After breakfast in hotel drive to Mandawa. En route sightseeing of Mukandgarh. Arrive Mandawa check into the hotel. Afternoon proceed for sightseeing tour of Mandawa, An open art gallery is what aptly describes Mandawa in Rajasthan. Mandawa Rajasthan is dotted with beautiful havelis, mansions and forts. This wealth of ancient architectural heritage is what that has made Mandawa a popular tourist destination in Rajasthan. Mandawa lies in the district of Jhunjhunu and havelis are the main tourist attractions in Mandawa. Night stay in Mandawa.

#### Day 09: Mandawa - Jaipur (212 km, 3 hours 19 mins)

Breakfast in Hotel, then proceed for full day visit of Havelis of Nawa Shekhawati, visit the Cenotaphs, Stepwells, beautifully Painted Havelis & Old Streets at Dundlod, Mandawa and Mukundgarh & evening drive to Jaipur. Night stay in Jaipur.

## Day 10: Jaipur

After relaxed breakfast in hotel, proceed for full day Full Day sight seeing of Amber Fort, City Palace, Jantar Mantar. The Amber Fort - set in picturesque and rugged hills is a fascinating blend of Mughal Architecture, construct by Raja Mann Singh in 1592 and completed by Swai Jai Singh, the fort is made in red sand stone and white marble. The rugged forbidding exterior belies an inner paradise with a beautiful of art and architecture. Amber Fort is the classic and romantic fort palace with a magnificent aura. The interior wall of palace depicts expressive painting scenes with carvings, precious stones and mirror settings. The City Palace located in the heart of the world city. The City Palace is a blend of Mughal and Rajasthani architecture and the royal family still lives in a part of the Palace. The building now forms the Maharaja Swai Man Singh II Museum and on display here are a wide array of royal costumes, some vary exquisite and precious pashmina (kashmiri) shawls, Benaras silk sarries sauganeri prints and folk embroidery. Night stay in Jaipur.

# Day 11: Jaipur - Agra (305 km, 4 hours 54 mins)

After leisurely Breakfast in hotel drive to Agra ,visiting Bharatpur bird Santury & Fatehpur Sikri on the way, transfer to hotel. Night stay in Agra.

## Day 12 : Jaipur - Agra (305 km, 4 hours 54 mins)

After breakfast in hotel, proceed for sightseeing of Agra. Visit the magnificient Taj Mahal - A white marble Tomb building 1631 - 1648 in Agra, seat of the Mughal Empire by Shah Jahan for his wife, Arjuman Banu Begum, the monument sums up many of the formal themes that have played through Islamic architecture. Its refined elegance is a conspicuous contrast both to the Hindu architecture of pre - Islamic India, with its thick walls, corbelled arches and heavy lintels and to the Indo Islamic styles, in which Hindu elements are combined with an electric assortment of motifs from Persian and Turkish sources. AGRA FORT- Fort built in red sandstone with its magnificent palaces, halls of public and private audience and the beautiful gardens. This is where Emperor Shah Jahan was kept under house arrest

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by his third son Aurangzeb and spent the last year of his life viewing the Taj Mahal from across the river Jamuna. Night stay in Agra.

Day 13: Jaipur - Agra

Breakfast in Hotel, after relaxed breakfast drive to Delhi visiting Sikandra Tomb on the way. On arrival at Delhi transfer to International Airport to board the onward flight.

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
