## Day 01: Arrive Gold Coast

Welcome to your tour of Australia !!! A country that offers you endless sun baked horizons, dense tropical rainforests, chilly southern beaches and much more. On arrival at Brisbane International Airport / Coolangata Airport, please proceed to the CON - X-ION counter located inside the airport terminal for your seat-in-coach shuttle bus transfer to your Gold Coast hotel. Overnight at the hotel, Gold Coast.

### Day 02 : Gold Coast

Enjoy Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Today you will be picked up from your hotel lobby for a tour to Movie World on seat in coach basis. Visit Warner Bros. Movie World on Australia Gold Coast - where movie magic happens every day! As the only Australian movie related theme park, you will experience a fun-filled, Gold Coast theme park family adventure with all the glitz and glamour of Hollywood. # Day 03 : Gold Coast

Enjoy Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Today you will be picked up from your hotel lobby for a tour to Sea World on seat in coach basis. Visit Sea World on Australia's Gold Coast! Make contact with marine life wonders and experience a whole world of amazing rides, shows and attractions at a Gold Coast theme park favourite! More than just a theme park, Sea World is committed to educating guests about the marine environment, and playing an active role in Australian marine research and rescue. Return to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel, Gold Coast.

Day 04: Gold Coast - Melbourne





Enjoy Buffet breakfast at the hotel. You will be met by our representative at your hotel lobby for your seat-in-coach shuttle bus transfer to Brisbane Airport / Coolangata Airport to meet with your onwards flight to Melbourne. Arrive Melbourne before 1040 hrs and join the Half Day Morning City Tour on seat in coach basis. Discover the charm of Melbourne. See Captain Cook's Cottage, Queen Victoria Market, Fitzroy Gardens and Albert Park, home to the Australian Grand Prix. Stroll the Royal Botanic Gardens, see the Royal Exhibition Buildings and Federation Square. Visit the Shrine of Remembrance and see the Southbank waterfront precinct. See some of the city's architecture including St. Paul's Cathedral and the Princess and Regent theaters. Cross the Bolte Bridge for great city views. Later walk across to Federation Wharf (Princes Walk) OR Southgate Arts Precinct to Join 1Hr Yarra River Cruise with Complimentary Tea/Coffee. Make your own way to the hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure. Overnight at the hotel, Melbourne.

#### Day 05: Melbourne

Enjoy Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy your tour to Phillip Island, home to an astounding array of wildlife, including Australia's largest fur seal colony, the Little Penguins and cuddly koalas. Enjoy getting close to koalas and kangaroos before joining the Little Penguins at dusk as they emerge from the surf and waddle to their burrows. Visit Warrook, a working cattle farm in the prosperous Gippsland region. Enjoy the opportunity to pat and feed kangaroos, wallabies and a host of farm animals. Encounter koalas in their natural habitat at the Koala Conservation Centre. Stroll along elevated boardwalks and spot koalas in the trees. View spectacular coastal scenery at the Nobbies, two rocky outcrops abundant in marine life. From the walkways you may be able to catch a glimpse of Australia's largest population of fur seals living along the rugged coastline. Browse through the educational Phillip Island Visitors Information Centre. Learn about the little penguins and life on this stunning island. Watch the Little Penguins as they battle the surf and make their way to their dune burrows and learn of the environmental and conservation methods that are initiated to ensure the remarkable wildlife and vulnerable geology of Phillip Island remains protected. See the Little Penguins up close as they return to their nests to greet their young families and view the powerful southern coastline with its clean, sandy beaches and rocky shores. Note: Nobbies viewing is seasonal and dependant on daylight hours. OR Enjoy a Full Day Tour of the Great Ocean Road. View the popular coastal townships of Torquay and Lorne - a surfer's haven and retreat. Pass world famous Bells Beach, home to World Surfing Championships. See many fern filled gullies and river inlets on your journey. Travel the length of the Great Ocean Road passing towering limestone cliffs, sweeping white beaches and stunning forest scenery. Truly one of the world's great scenic coastal drives. Witness a fabulous spectacle of massive natural erosion. Contrasts abound between rugged coast and verdant rainforest living side by side. See the amazing Twelve Apostles - limestone stacks rising dramatically from the Southern Ocean and visit the Information Centre. Walk along the boardwalk and enjoy the scenery from various viewing platforms. See Loch Ard Gorge and be swept away by the romantic and tragic story of love and lives lost aboard the Loch Ard. Explore Port Campbell National Park. Discover the tragic history of over 50 ships wrecked along this rugged coastline. Continue beyond Port Campbell to the remnants of London Bridge. Don't forget extra film as we embark on a number of great photo locations including Razorback and Island Arch. See the spectacular night lights of Melbourne as you cross the West Gate Bridge. OR Enjoy the Sovereign Hill Gold Mine, Ballarat & Wildlife Tour. The past is very much present in towns like Ballarat whose early wealth and proud history was due to the mighty gold discovery of the mid 1850s. The glorious legacy that gold bestowed on this colonial town is still evident in the respectfully restored buildings and atmosphere of proud Ballarat. Sovereign Hill in Ballarat is a perfectly re-created example of Gold rush life during Victoria's Golden era. Explore the daily ritual of this Gold town and stroll the main street to visit with goldsmiths, crafts people, traders, soldiers and the like. Find your own fortune whilst panning for gold in the stream, go "underground" to the fascinating Gold mine and museum or ride the stage-coach through the village. Exhibits and displays unfold before you as you stroll though this bustling pioneer township. Have a chat to the gentle town folk and be captivated by the friendly outlook on their 1850s daily life. Overnight at the hotel, Melbourne.

#### Day 06: Melbourne - Cairns

Enjoy Buffet breakfast at the hotel. You will be met by our representative at your hotel lobby for your seat-in-coach shuttle bus transfer to Melbourne Airport to meet with your onwards flight to Cairns. On arrival in Cairns you will be met by an Airport Connections Representative or Driver will be at the baggage collection carousels and will be holding





an AIRPORT CONNECTIONS sign for your shuttle bus transfer to Kuranda. The picturesque mountain retreat of Kuranda Village is just 25km northwest of Cairns in Far North Queensland, Australia and is surrounded by World Heritage Rainforest. Arrive at the Village in the Rainforest "Kuranda" and board the Skyrail. Skyrail Rainforest Cableway, Cairns Australia, is a world first in environmental tourism taking you on an amazing experience over Australia's World Heritage listed Tropical Rainforest canopy and deep into the forest. The Skyrail experience, spanning 7.5kms over pristine rainforest, allows you to explore the wonders of an ancient tropical rainforest and learn about one of the most botanically fascinating and diverse areas on earth. Gliding just metres above the rainforest canopy in comfortable sixperson gondola cabins, the Skyrail journey immerses you in an intimate rainforest experience where you'll see, hear, smell and become part of the tropical rainforest environment. A one-way Skyrail Experience will take approximately 90 minutes to complete. Transfer to the Hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure. Overnight at the hotel, Cairns.

## Day 07: Cairns

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Today enjoy a full day Great Adventure OUTER Barrier Reef Cruise Tour with Tropical Lunch. The beauty of the Great Barrier Reef is yours to experience when you cruise to our mulit-level reef activity platform. ## Day 09: Sydney

In the evening proceed on OWN to King Street Wharf # 5, Darling Harbour by 1850-1900hrs to join Sydney ShowBoat STANDARD Indian Dinner Cruise (No Transfers - No Cruising WED/SUN). #### Day 10: Sydney

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Today you will be picked up from your hotel lobby for a Full Day excursion to the Blue Mountains including the entry to the Wildlife Park. Travel west beyond the suburban sprawl of Sydney into the rugged beauty of the World Heritage-listed Blue Mountains National Park. See magnificent steep valleys, canyons and the Three Sisters on the Skyway, Scenic Railway or Cableway (own expense). Listen to ancient Aboriginal Dreamtime legends before travelling via the townships of Leura and Katoomba. Journey along the scenic Bells Line of Road and enjoy a stop at Govetts Leap and Cahills Lookout for fabulous views. Enjoy a walk among the native bush and visit an Australian wildlife park with an opportunity to touch a cuddly koala and see kangaroos, wombats, dingoes and other unique Australian animals in this natural setting.
